

SEC³URE Facility | Identify HCIR / Rep Badge Styles



When a badge is printed, **Base** HCIRs receive **landscape oriented** badges and **Premium** and **Passport** HCIRs receive **portrait oriented** badges. This is so the two groups can be easily distinguished within the facility.

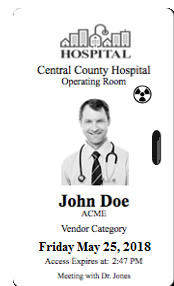
SEC³URE tracks the HCIRs / Reps entering and leaving your facilities as well as matches them to the credentials and policies you want enforced. If an HCIR arrives onsite and finds his/her way past the front desk without checking in, and if no one from the facility stops the HCIR to ask him/her about a badge, your facility is being exposed. That HCIR could have revoked privileges, skipped his/her shots, or failed to acknowledge facility policies.

Ultimately, the key to facility security is EVERYONE doing their part to enforce your credential and policy requirements. We all play a role.

Radiation Indicator:



If you or anyone else in the facility spots the radiation symbol on the badge, check to ensure the HCIR / Vendor Rep is also wearing a Radiation Monitoring Dosimeter.



Seasonal Flu Indicator:

During flu season (*October – March*), SEC³URE badges will display the word “MASK” for anyone who has not received the current seasonal flu vaccine.
